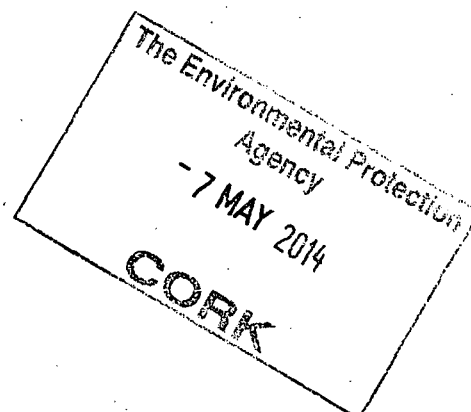
I refer to EPA letter dated 10th April 2014 in relation to an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) licence for Cook Ireland.

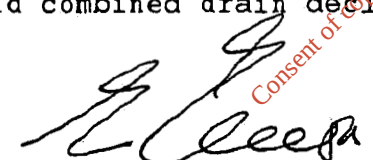
SUBJECT

Section 22 - Local Government (Water Pollution)(Amendment) Act, 1990.

Declaration of Combined Drain at Plassey Technological Park, Plassey, Castletroy, Co. Limerick, to be a sewer for the purposes of the Local Government (Water Pollution) Acts, 1977 & 1990.

ORDER

It is hereby ordered that pursuant to the provisions of Section 22 of the Local Government (Water Pollution) (Amendment) Act, 1990, the combined drain located at Plassey Technological Park, Plassey, Castletroy, Co. Limerick, shall become and be a sewer for the purpose of requiring separate licences for the licensable effluent discharges to the combined drain located at Plassey Technological Park, this Order shall become operational on the 30th July, 1995. It is further ordered that a Notice to this effect be served on the owners and occupiers of premises discharging matter into the aforesaid combined drain declared to be a sewer.
