Proposed Development: Pacon intends to apply for planning permission and a revised Waste Permit to increase the amount and types of waste accepted at the facility to 49,950 tonnes/year, amend the acceptance and operational times to allow for 24/7 operations and introduce a new waste processing line to manufacture solid recovered fuel. The changes do not require any construction works or alterations to the existing site layout and drainage systems. All waste processes will continue to be carried out inside the building.

We have made observations and submissions on the following specific EH area;



ASSESSMENT OF NOISE

The EHS recommends that other units within the industrial estate (Fingal Bay Business Park, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin) should be considered as possible Noise Sensitive Locations. For this reason, the acceptable noise levels should be at the location/site boundary as per EPA Guidance Note for Noise: Licence Applications, Surveys and Assessments in Relation to Scheduled Activities (NG4).
