

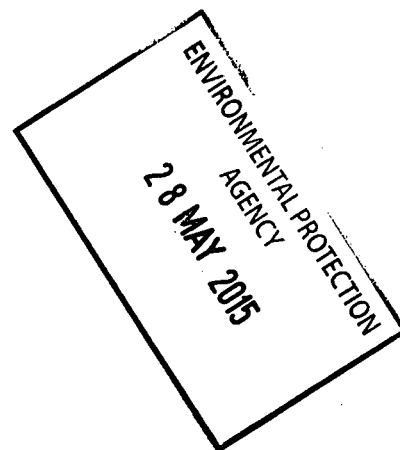

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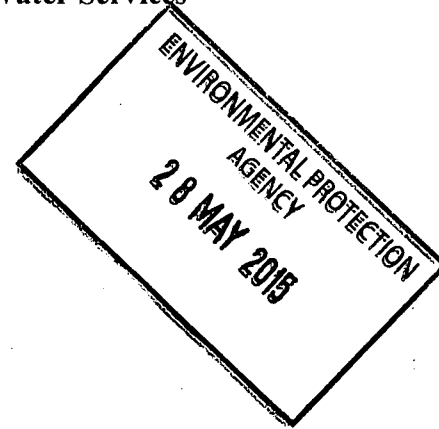

Non-Compliance of Permit Conditions



Dear Mr Kiernan,

With reference to the above waste permit and to an inspection that was carried out by James McCaldin, Clerk of Works and Ciara Coughlan, Environmental Technician on the 20th May 2015, I am to inform you that you are in breach of the following conditions of your permit:

- Condition 1.4 refers to phased filling in phases 1, 2 and 3 of the quarry with design levels.
- Condition 4.2 refers to the haul road using good clean quality hardcore material, sourced from Mr. Kiernan's quarry.
- Condition 4.6 Soil and Stone (Waste Code 17 05 04) is the only permissible waste to be imported.
- Conditions 4.7 and 4.8 refer to permit holder who shall erect markers indicating the finished levels at sufficient locations around the site to ensure that the finished levels comply with the topographical drawings submitted to the Council on the 5th March 2007.
- Condition 4.6 refers to filling for haul routes. This has been established; therefore no further imported concrete waste is permitted at the facility.
 - *Condition 4.13 Only uncontaminated soil and stone waste, which conforms to the European Waste Catalogue (2002 edition) code reference 17 05 04 (soil and stones) may be accepted at the site. Concrete waste, conforming to European Waste Catalogue code reference 17 01 01, may be accepted on the site only for the purposes of constructing the haul road. No other waste types shall be accepted or deposited at this facility. The permit holder shall ensure that adequate steps are taken to prevent acceptance of any other waste types.*
- Condition 5.4 states 'The permit holder shall take adequate steps to ensure that vehicles exiting from the site do not deposit material of any sort onto the public roadway or adjoining lands.'
- Condition 5.7 refers to permit holder having a road sweeper on site to care for the public road. This was absent at time of inspection. We hereby remind permit holder of the importance of maintaining the road.


- Condition 5.9 refers to the use of the wheel wash. This plant was non operational at time of inspection and should have been working.

Please be advised that a follow up site inspection of the facility will be undertaken four weeks from the date of this letter. By that time all issues of non-conformance should be addressed. Please be advised that failure to act on this direction is an offence against the Waste Management Act which may in turn lead to prosecution.

You are advised to contact this office to arrange a meeting with our technical staff in County Hall, Railway Street, Navan in relation to the conditions of your waste permit. Please contact this office on 046-9097208 to arrange a suitable time and date.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the conditions of a permit is an offence under the Waste Management Acts 1996-2010 and may lead to prosecution.
