Outlined below are heritage-related observations/recommendations of the Department under the stated heading(s).

## Archaeology

The Department concurs with the recommendations in the EIS in relation to the mitigation of any possible impacts of the proposed development. Therefore we recommend that archaeological monitoring be carried out during the construction phase of the proposed development.

## Archaeological Monitoring shall consist of the following:

- 1. The applicant is required to employ a qualified archaeologist to monitor all groundworks associated with the development.
- 2. Should archaeological material be found during the course of monitoring, the archaeologist may have work on the site stopped, pending a decision as to how best to deal with the archaeology. The developer shall be prepared to be advised by the Cork County Archaeologist in consultation with the National Monuments Service with regard to any necessary mitigating action (e.g. preservation *in situ*, or excavation) and should facilitate the archaeologist in recording any material found.
- 3. The Planning Authority, the EPA and the Department of Arts, Heritage and the Gaeltacht shall be furnished with a report describing the results of the monitoring.

<u>Reason:</u> To ensure the continued preservation (either *in situ* or by record) of places, caves, sites, features or other objects of archaeological interest.
