I believe that dumping 10 million tons of polluted silt into Dublin Bay will destroy Dublin Bay. The proposed area for dumping is either in or adjacent to a special area of conservation. The last time dredging was carried out in Dublin Port the silt was carried in the tide right down the east coast and seriously affected commercial fishing.
