**1. General Introduction**

**This report only comments on Environmental Health (EH) Impacts of the proposed development as outlined in this licence application from an EH viewpoint. We have made observations and submissions on the following specific EH areas;**

**Hydrology / Hydrogeology:**

**Observation:**

- It is noted that the facility is serviced by a Waste Water Treatment system which appears to discharge to a percolation area located on the western side of the site. Planning permission has been previously granted by Longford County Council to connect to the public sewerage system via a pumping station. This has also been included in a new application submitted to Longford Co. Co. in July 2015 - Ref: No 15/116.

- The Surface Water monitoring related only to three samples taken in May 2015
  1. The Storm Water Discharge Pipe identified as SW1.
  2. Receiving Stream ASW0001 (Upstream)
  3. Receiving Stream ASW -002 (Downstream)There is no sample result from Storm water Discharge Pipe – SW-2  
All other sample results submitted with the application were taken in 2007.


- We note that the Noise survey was carried out in 2007.
