Industrial Emissions Licence Application, Colm Ryan, Nantinan, Milltown**

**A Chara,**

I refer to previous correspondence regarding the above and in particular to yours of 21<sup>st</sup> September 2015 in relation to an Application for Industrial Emissions Licence Ref P1031-01 on behalf of Colm Ryan for a pig rearing facility at Nantinan, Milltown, Co Kerry.

Firstly, I wish to confirm that the information contained in the Kerry County Council letter issued to Montgomery EHS Ltd dated 7<sup>th</sup> September 2015 is incorrect as three applications for planning permission were made on the lands by Maine Valley Co-Op Society Ltd as follows:

Planning Register No 9897: Permission granted on 14/03/1972 for the erection of a 3,000 Pig Fattening Unit.

Planning Register No 75/834: Permission granted for the erection of extension to pig fattening unit.

Planning Register No 79/1246: Permission granted for the construction of pig fattening unit and hospital unit.

Secondly, in reply to issues raised in EPA letter, it is the view of Kerry County Council that the activity to which the Industrial Emissions Licence Application relates does not require planning permission as no works and no material change of use are proposed. I also wish to confirm that no EIA was carried out by Kerry County Council for any development on the lands as the only planning applications relating to the lands were made in the 1970s.
