

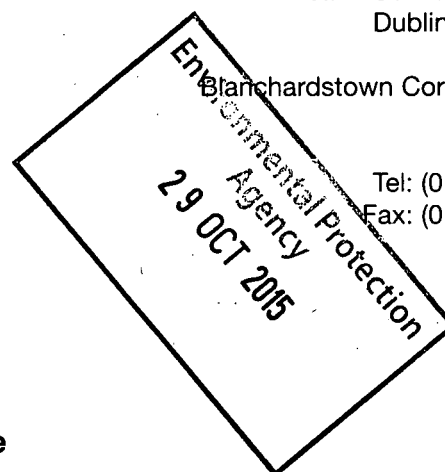

The Environmental Health Service (EHS) has assessed the Environmental Licence review and the relevant information associated with the above application following notification received from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on 22 September 2015.

In response to the notification of the licence review, the following Health Service Executive departments were made aware of the consultation request on 22 September 2015:

- Emergency Planning,
- Estates – Environmental Services,
- Assistant National Director for Health Protection,
- Community Healthcare Organisation.

An acknowledgement of the notification was received from Emergency Planning stating that Emergency Planning had no comment at this time. No other responses were received within the timeline set by the office of the Assistant National Director of Environmental Health.


Accordingly, the EHS response to the proposal is as follows:

1. This office is concerned primarily with highlighting issues of public health and environmental health concern. Our files indicate that this office has received no complaints in relation to this proposed facility.
2. The assessment was based on a review of documentation submitted to this office on the 22 September 2015 by the EPA. As well as a study of the application, Environmental Impact Statement and associated correspondence and documentation on the EPA website. No additional measurements were undertaken.
3. Environmental Health were not included at the Screening/Scoping stage of this application
4. All commitments to future actions including mitigation and further testing have been taken as read and all data results have been accepted as accurate.
5. This report refers only to those sections of the documents which are relevant to the HSE.

At present I have no submission or comment to make in relation to this environmental licence review currently being considered by the EPA.
