In reference to EPA Application No. P1031-01 I wish to draw attention to the following:

Ref: 5.2.1.2 Odours

The applicant, Colm Ryan's assertion that there has been no complaints in relation to odours emanating from the Piggery is false.

"Mr Ryan has never received any complaint directly in relation to his piggery from a local resident, Local Authority, EPA, HSE, etc. In previous planning application there has never been complaints to the planning authority in relation to odours" (Page 13 of Environmental Impact Assessment).

We have a home at Nantinan, approximately 200 metres from the site. In 2013 we noted a strong on-going odour from the Piggery. During that summer we called to Department of Environment, Kerry County

Council, in Tralee and spoke with Mr Stuart Roche and Mr Kenneally. We enquired about the facility and the odour and, while helpful, they promised to look into it. We discovered that the owner of the facility was Colm Ryan.

We contacted the owner by telephone on several occasions to complain. We were unhappy with his responses and insisted he call to our home. We met him on two occasions. Over the past twelve months the odour has got worse. We were forced to call him again on a number of occasions requesting him to take action. There has been no improvement.

As we are involved in attracting tourists from all over the world to our home we now find it impossible to carry on our business as on a number of occasions guests have been forced to leave the area due to the strong and persistent odour.

We have been unable to open windows, hang clothes on line, allow children to play in the garden or enjoy the lovely scenic countryside.
