Dear Mr. Doyle,

I understand that the monitoring of “customer farmer spreadlands” on which slurry arising from this piggery is spread is not within the scope of this application – that the IPPC cannot control anything outside of the piggery site.

I note written agreement for compliance with E.C (Good Agricultural Practice for the Protection of Waters) Regulations 2014 is obtained from each customer farmer.

In view of the proximity to local watercourses, and as the EIS states “the spreadlands occur within the arbitrary zone of contribution (1,000m) of the Clonbullogue Public Water Supply”, monitoring of the catchment area should be carried out by the appropriate authority to ensure compliance with the above Regulations
