Re: P1026-01, Application by Kiernan Milling for an IPPC Licence

I have concerns regarding the planned expansion of the Animal Feed Mill Facility in Granardkille, Co. Longford owned by Kiernan Milling. This facility already contributes a significant volume of traffic to the local area and any increase in production will increase the traffic volume. The Feriskill Road is a small country road which is not designed to accommodate the large volume of Articulated Lorries that use it as a short cut when traveling to and from the Kiernan Milling Facility.

The use of the Feriskill Road by Kiernan Milling is a breach of planning as it is stipulated in condition No. 2 of Planning Reference No: 10/125 granted by Longford County Council on 30/04/2010 that haulage trucks accessing and delivering from the mill not use this road. Unfortunately Kiernan Milling have not adhered to this condition and have continued to use the Feriskill Road.
