

Nature Conservation

In relation to marine habitats and species it is recommended to the Competent Authority that the following mitigating measures be applied as conditions of consent:

1. All mitigating measures outlined in Section 3.4 and sub-headings of the supporting Natura Impact Statement must be implemented in full.
2. The MMO will keep a record of the monitoring using a MMO form location and effort (coastal works) (or similar) available from the National Parks & Wildlife Service (NPWS) and submit to the Competent Authority on completion of the works, as described in the NPWS guidance (2014).
