I would like to object to the application by dublin Port for a dumping at sea license to dump spoil from Alexandra basin into Dublin Bay. I worked as a fishery Officer in Dublin during the seventies and eighties and witnessed the pollution entering the River Liffey from the CAmac river which was largely from Smurfits paper factory in Clondalkin. This contains high levels of heavy metals. These would once again be mobilised by any disturbance of the sediment and Dublin Bay is a biosphere reserve which should be protected.
