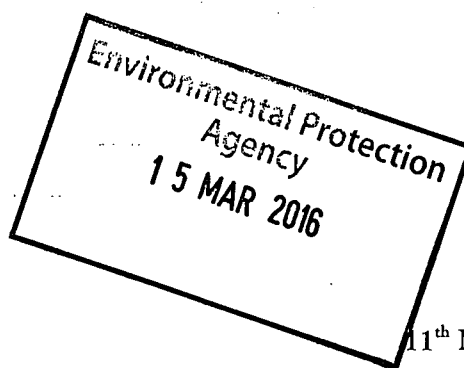

Re: Notification under Section 87(1E)(a) of the EPA Act 1992, as amended.

Dear Ms. Leacy,

I refer to the correspondence dated 18th February 2016 and 3rd March 2016 regarding Licence Application P1037-01 for Mr. J. Sheridan, Levally, Ballinrobe, Co. Mayo.

1. State whether the activity to which the licence application relates is permitted by the grant of permission referred to above.

The applicant has applied for an Industrial Emission Activity Licence in relation to both Class 11.1 and Class 11.4(b)(i). However, the planning permission was granted on the basis of 25,830 tonnes per annum in accordance with the details supplied by the applicant in the planning application and also the EIS documentation. The applicant has also stated in the Industrial Emission Activity application to the EPA that the maximum annual tonnage is 25,830 tonnes. Therefore, as this is less than 75 tonnes per day, it appears that Class 11.4(b)(i) is not applicable in this case. The activity to which the licence application relates with regard to Class 11.1 is permitted by the grant of permission P11/753.
