Please find below Irish Water's comment in relation to objections made by Kingspan Insulation Limited in accordance with article 26 of the Environmental Protection Agency (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013. In making comment, Irish Water refer to Request 5, 6 and 8 of the Kingspan Insulation Limited letter dated 20th May 2016 and respond accordingly;

Request 5: Modification of reporting frequency, Condition 11.13

Irish Water is satisfied that the word "monthly" within Condition 11.13 of the Proposed Determination may be replaced by "quarterly"

Request 6: Modification of wording in Condition 11.15 and Method of Sampling in Schedule C.3.2 (Monitoring of emissions to sewer).

Irish Water is satisfied that a representative sample of trade effluent discharged to sewer may be obtained via a grab sample if certain onsite operational processes are adhered to. Therefore the following amendments to the proposed determination would be acceptable to Irish Water:

Condition 11.15 of Proposed Determination:

Delete the word "composite".

Schedule C.3.2 (Monitoring of emissions to sewer) of Proposed Determination:

Amend Note 1 to read as follows:

"Samples of trade effluent shall be obtained via representative grab samples unless otherwise requested in writing by Irish Water."

Request 8: Details contained in Schedule B3.1: Emissions to Sewer

Irish Water is satisfied that the changes to Schedule B3.1 as outlined in Request 8 of the Kingspan Insulation Limited letter dated 20th May 2016 can be incorporated into the Proposed Determination.
