

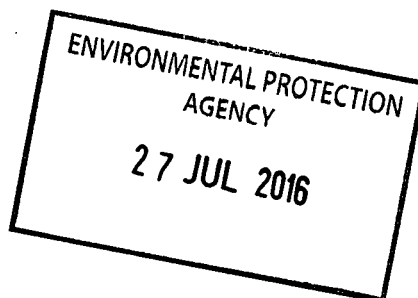

- The assessment is based solely on receipt of EPA documentation submitted to this office on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2016 by National Environmental Health Office.



- A review of Environmental Impact Statement was undertaken. As this EIS was prepared in 2003 it is not considered appropriate to comment in detail as some of the information may be out of date.
- A review of the EIS Non-Technical Summary 2003 was also carried out. There was no record of any Public Consultation process noted.
- This office is concerned primarily with highlighting issues of public health and environmental health concern. To the best of our knowledge this office has received no environmental complaints in relation to this facility.
- Environmental Health were not included at the Screening / Scoping stage of this EIS application
- All commitments to future actions including mitigation and further testing have been taken as read and all data results have been accepted as accurate.
- No additional investigations / measurements were undertaken.
