Dear Ms Keavey,

I refer to your correspondence dated 17th June 2016 regarding an application from Quinn Cement Limited, Scotchtown, Ballyconnell, County Cavan for an Industrial Emissions Licence review.

Irish Water have assessed the Industrial Emissions licence review application P0378-03 and have determined that the discharge to sewer as described in the Quinn Cement Limited application is of a domestic type (i.e. sanitary wastewater from toilets, wash basins, showers etc.). Quinn Cement Limited has confirmed in writing to Irish Water that there are no restaurants or canteen/kitchen facilities onsite which has the potential to add Fats, Oils & Grease (FOG) to their discharge.

Irish Water are therefore satisfied that Quinn Cement Limited do not require Irish Water's consent to discharge to sewer in accordance with Section 99E of the EPA Act 1992, as amended, as they not produce a "trade effluent" emission to sewer.

I trust this response satisfies Irish Water's requirement pursuant to your notice dated 17th June 2016.
