Outlined below please find the Nature Conservation observations.

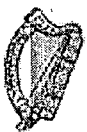

It is this Departments recommendation that Appropriate Assessment Screening should be carried out (at least) with a focus to include an assessment of the spread lands potential effect on any SAC or SPA's and a map should be provided of the proposed spread lands.
