We refer to the above mentioned application in relation to a poultry rearing facility at Doogary, Tydavnet.

Inland Fisheries Ireland (IFI) is a Statutory Body established on the 1st July 2010. Under section 7(1) of the Inland Fisheries Act 2010 (No. 10 of 2010) the principal function of IFI is the protection, management and conservation of the inland fisheries resource.

IFI has no objection to this application from a fisheries perspective, provided that:

- The number of poultry housed shall not exceed that in the application.
- All effluent, soiled water and solid wastes shall be stored on site in adequately sized and sited watertight structures.
- All effluent to be disposed of by land spreading shall be carried out in accordance with the Good Agricultural Practice for the Protection of Waters Regulations 2014.
- Only clean, uncontaminated storm water shall be discharged to a soak-away system or to surface water.

The site is located in the Dundonagh River catchment, which is a sub catchment of the Mountain Water River catchment. The current status of this waterbody (Mountain Water_050 - Code IE_NB_03M010650) is Moderate and is At Risk of not achieving Good Status.

Both the Dundonagh and Mountain Water Rivers contain salmonid spawning and nursery habitat, therefore, it is important to ensure the proposed development does not have a negative impact on the aquatic habitat.
