Upon completion of the placement of the surplus dredge spoil material, the site will be developed into an Eco-Park. The proposed development will comprise: • Clearance of vegetation from the existing site and chipping/shredding of vegetation prior to movement offsite for appropriate management • Redevelopment of existing entrance, incorporating boundary treatment • Placement of up to 200,000 tonnes of dredge spoil at the site • Installation of temporary (construction period) and longer term surface water management infrastructure

- 3. All proposed noise attenuation measures and monitoring be incorporated into conditions any permission.

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- 4. That the activity be conditioned not to cause noise nuisance to any surrounding residents
- 5. The provisions regarding quarantine of suspect loads be incorporated into conditions of any permission
- 6. That the hours of operation be 07.00 to 19.00 Mon to Friday 08.00 to 14.00 Sat and not at all on Sunday and Bank Holidays
