No consultation reports have been received from the above departments at the time of issue of this correspondence.

This Industrial Emissions Licence Application was assessed with respect to Environmental Health (EH) Impacts of the activity as outlined in the application. The assessment consisted of a study of the application and associated correspondence and documentation on the EPA website.

A site visit was conducted on 19/05/2017.

No additional measurements / investigations were undertaken.

No complaints in relation to the past or present operations at this facility have been received by this department regarding this operation.

During my site visit it was noted that odours at the site of the operation were evident. Odour levels from the facility must be such so as not to cause undue nuisance or annoyance to sensitive receptors in the area or will not interfere with the amenity outside the boundary of the site.

Provided that the measures as outlined in the support documentation submitted with this licence application are fully adhered to and the odour situation as mentioned is closely monitored and attended to as necessary the Environmental Health Department of the HSE South (Kerry) would not have any general concerns with this licence application which is currently being considered by the EPA.
