Over the last few weeks I have compiled some information with worrying results.

(1) That landfills are taking in over loaded trucks exceeding 50 tonnes in weight, one in particular is Bord na Mona at Dredid in Co Kildare (a semi state body) that have taken in over loaded trucks in the past exceeding 50 tonnes and if Kilsaran Concrete increase there existing weigh bridge from 50 to 60 tonnes well then this becomes quite worrying to the general public and road users, are Kilsaran Concrete and yourself willing to condone such practices.?

(2) There are strong rumors coming from Kilberry Navan that the landfill at Randalstown was closed by the EPA for the last few weeks due to contamination , this also concerns me,

(3) I have received a letter form Ciara Coughlin from the Environmental Section of Meath Co Co Ref WM14/2017 outlining that all waste at Tullykane Quarry was removed and that 51 receipts have been submitted to Meath Co Co , lets take an average load at 25 tonnes by 51 = 1.275 tonnes that's quite a lot of waste
