I refer to your correspondence dated 15th September 2017 regarding an application from Micro-Bio (Ireland) Limited, Industrial Estate, Fermoy, County Cork for an Industrial Emissions Licence review.

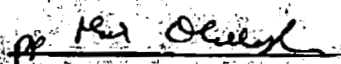
Irish Water have assessed the Industrial Emissions licence review application P0082-03 and other records pertaining to the pipe to which the discharge is proposed to be made and have determined that the proposed discharge is to a 'storm water sewer' which is not vested in Irish Water.

Irish Water are therefore satisfied that Micro-Bio (Ireland) Limited do not require Irish Water's consent to discharge to sewer in accordance with Section 99E of the EPA Act 1992, as amended, as the proposed discharge is to a 'storm water sewer' which is not vested in Irish Water.
