A Chara,

I refer to your email correspondence of the 24th January last in connection with above.

Kilkenny County Council has the below comments to make:

1) Note condition 5 of permission 08/1499 (PL10.23546)

This permission is limited to Phase 1 only (including landscaping works). The time period permitted shall not exceed a total of 14 years from the date of grant of this permission (12 years for extraction and 2 years thereafter for landscaping and restoration works). The maximum depth of extraction shall be to 35m AOD.

No extraction shall be carried out beyond the 12 years permitted, or below 35m aOD, unless a prior grant of permission, under a separate planning application, has been received prior to the expiry of the 12 years permitted for extraction under this grant of permission.

Reason: In the interests of clarity, residential amenities, and the proper planning and sustainable development of the area, and to enable the Planning Authority to review changes in environmental standards and technology over the duration of this permission.

Currently the quarry is in year 8 of a 14 year permission however it should be noted The 14 years was to allow for 12 years of extraction and 2 years for restoration and the permission limits them to phase 1 only – i.e. bench 1 and 2 to a depth of 35m OD.

Therefore the activity is authorised subject to compliance with all conditions but limited to Phase 1 only with extraction only authorised until December 2022
