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## **Environmental Health Report**

The EH service response to the proposal is as follows:

The assessment is based on receipt of EPA documentation submitted to this office on the 18/01/2018 by National Environmental Health Office

A site visit was carried out at the facility on the 23/01/2018.

This office is concerned primarily with highlighting issues of public health and environmental health concerns. This office has received no environmental complaints in relation to the past or present operation at this facility.

All commitments to future actions including mitigation and further testing have been taken as read and all data results have been accepted as accurate.

No additional investigations / measurements were undertaken.

In relation to these types of developments the areas of concern from an environmental health perspective are soils and geology, water, air quality, noise and material assets. These areas of concern have been addressed in the EIAR accompanying this application. Provided that the measures as outlined in the EIAR are strictly adhered to and that best available techniques (BAT) for waste treatment are complied with this department would have no other response to make in relation to the proposal.
