We wish to make a submission concerning the request by the above company Murphy Environmental Hollywood for a license to landfill hazardous and toxic waste at Hollywood.

My name is Moore I am seventy eight years of age. I have farmed this land with my wife my entire life as have my parents before me. We have grown up children whom are thinking of starting families in the near future. Our farm is bordered by this proposed facility.

We wish this application to be rejected and are gravely concerned for the welfare of Ourselves, our family, and our neighboring community. This is due to;

Fear of bad health cancers and respiratory Illness. We are very concerned about the toxic nature of this waste. By its nature toxic ash could be airborne thereby the people in the area with asthma and respiratory complaints would be seriously affected and confined indoors. This would compromise their quality of life which is a fundamental right.

Total destruction of property value & prices

Water is an important resource. It is in proximity to the Bog of the Ring, natural springs and underground water. We intend to build and drill for a well on our own land in the future; we know there is an adequate supply to be had. But are concerned this introduction of toxic waste to the area would deprive us of this natural resource.

Noise pollution is a grave concern. This proposed facility is on a narrow winding bendy country road. In order to transport the maximum tonnage allowed per annum this would take an enormous volume of heavy truck movements. There are no footpaths, street lighting and the road surface is in poor repair. Walking & exercise to keep our health in good condition would be impossible due to the proposed volume of truck movements.

The location of this facility, to landfill hazardous toxic ash waste, is on top of one of the highest hills in scenic & historical north country Dublin zoned H/A. This is a windswept hill; there is no shelter or windbreak. The winds will vacuum everything that is within the quarry and we are of the opinion that toxic contamination of the surrounding lands and towns will be inevitable.

This is farming land; fresh produce is grown for human consumption. We need to be guaranteed the ability to continue to do so without impairment. This would not be possible if this license is granted.

There is a proposed new school at Hedgestown all these trucks would have to pass this new school which is a risk.

With respect, the ability of the EPA to police this proposed facility, should it be granted a licence, is of grave concern to us as residents. We are in fear for our health and quality of life and that of our offspring.
