RE: CONSTRUCTION OF A 25M HIGH CHIMNEY STACK TO RELACE EXISTING 15 METRE STACK - APPEAL SUBMITTED IN RELATION TO THE ABOVE DEVELOPMENT – BRANDON PRODUCTS, KILCOLMAN, ASDEE, CO. KERRY - SUBMISSION A

We act on behalf of the applicant, Brandon Products Ltd, for the above planning application. We intend to make 2 submissions, the first being this submission, SUBMISSION A, which deals with two administrative issues and SUBMISSION B under separate cover, which deals with the issues raised in the appeal.

Under this submission, SUBMISSION A, we wish to make two points:

Point 1

It is our opinion, submitted on behalf of our client Brandon Products Ltd, that the appeal as submitted is vexatious in nature and we respectfully submit that it should be declared INVALID, as the grounds for appeal are difficult to discern from the appeal document submitted. The proposed stack is designed to ameliorate the potential impacts of any odour emissions, so to appeal the grant of a permission for a structure which is designed to reduce odour impacts is, in our opinion, vexatious, and serves no relevant planning purpose.

Point 2

We note that in your letter to us of 12 November 2014, your reference is to "Brendan Products Ltd", and we would respectfully ask that you amend this reference to "Brandon Products Ltd", which is the name of the Applicant.
