Re: Construction of a 25 metre high chimney stack to replace existing 15 metre stack. This development requires an integrated pollution prevention and control licence. Kilcolman, Asdee, Co. Kerry.	

This is a third party appeal, lodged on 11th November 2014, against the decision of Kerry County Council, on 15th October 2014, to grant permission for the proposed development.

A copy of the appeal was sent to the applicant and the planning authority on 12th November 2014. A response was received from the applicant within the appropriate period and is attached to the file. It is not considered necessary to invoke section 131 of the Act as no new material planning issues are raised.

EPA/EIS: A submission by the EPA to the planning authority states that an application has been made in respect of the subject site for an IPPC licence and that following a request by the EPA an EIS was submitted. An EIS did not accompany the planning application. An EIS not submitted form has been attached to the file for completion and review by the Inspector.

Should the Board be of the view that an EIS is required in respect of the planning application and same is received, it will be necessary to invite a submission from the EPA.
