

Dear Sir/Madam,

I refer to the above-mentioned proposed development which is the subject of a current determination on whether an environmental impact statement is required in accordance with the provisions of section 173A(5) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as inserted by Article 8 of the European (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2012. The application relates to a proposed development which may comprise or is for the purpose of an activity for which an Integrated Prevention and Pollution Control licence is required. The Board wishes to emphasise that the proposed development before the Board is in relation to the replacement chimney stack only.

The preliminary view of the Board is that an environmental impact assessment is **not** required. If the Environmental Protection Agency is of the view that a licence or review of a licence is required in respect of the proposed development, you are requested to submit your observations in relation to the preliminary determination. Your submission in response to this notice should be received within 3 weeks of the date of this letter i.e. **not later than 5.30 p.m. on the 18th February, 2015.**
