To whom it may Concern,

I wish to acknowledge to Kildare County Council, that I strongly oppose to permission to grant license to the application concerning GCHL Ltd W0298-01 at Ballinderry Carbury, Broadford Co. Kildare.

School Safety: As a parent of a school going child in Broadford National School, the safety of all the children as well as parents and family members that may be escorting the children to the school is paramount. At the moment, the level of traffic on this busy road outside the school is already enormous, with many a near miss incident already occurring. To increase the traffic volume in this area, with up to an additional 80 large lorries on a daily basis is just highly concerning to any parent, or family within the area. The car park across the road is the main car park for this school, and every morning and evening, trying to cross this road with children in tow, is challenge at times, with the volume of traffic. Some parents are crossing with 2 or 3 children in age ranges from babies in arms up to teenagers to watch along with many vehicles that pass no heed to the speed ramps already in the area. To allow for this license of a waste facility to go ahead at the above mentioned site, only means a significant increase to this traffic volume, and will in turn cause additional unnessecary risks to all families within the area using the carpark, not only school goers, but also mass goers, as many people attend mass here on a regular basis quite a number of times a week. If as a parent you are lucky enough to park on the school side of the road, trying to drive out of these spots, with school children and high traffic on the road is already quite dangerous, and if the license was granted it would increase these Health and Safety risks to quite alarming levels.

Inadequate road Infrastructure: On a regular basis I use the road within the area going walking and cycling. As it stands there is no footpaths or no proper edging in the way. This leaves the road dangerous for pedestrians and cyclist alike. Increasing the volume of traffic in this area particularly with trucks and lorries, is very worrying to a road that already has such high volume of traffic.

History of the site and pride within our community: A fact you are more than aware of, is the 216 skeletons uncovered on the site a number of years ago. A number of these was recovered, however, the locals were advised of a preservation on some of the site with respect for the other human remains, and the locals honoured these by erecting a Celtic cross where on cemetery Sunday every year, we gather to mark this site. The locals give great respect to this site, and this I strongly feel should be taking into any application consideration.

To reiterate my points, that the safety of our School Children who have to cross an already busy road, to the families that are crossing and using an already busy road, for the respect of the human remains that lay on this site, and importantly, for you to strongly remember that this company already has previous breeches of permission against their name, I strongly urge you to not allow the licensing of this to be allowed.
