Please find the nature conservation recommendations of the Department of Culture, Heritage, and the Gaeltacht for the above mentioned application.

The proposed seabed dredging and dumping-at-sea of sediment from Dublin Port channel has been evaluated by both a Natura Impact Statement and amongst others a Marine Mammal Risk Assessment.

The conclusion of the Natura Impact Statement document is that the proposed works are unlikely to pose a significant likely risk to nature conservation interests in the vicinity provided appropriate mitigation is implemented. The Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht concur with this conclusion.

The conclusion of the Marine Mammal Risk Assessment recommends the application of NPWS Guidelines to minimise the acoustic impacts of dredging and dumping-at-sea. With full application it is considered there would be no significant impacts to marine mammals or the associated conservation objectives of Rockabill to Dalkey Island SAC.

The proponent should also ensure that other activities not covered by the EPA Dumping-at-Sea Consent application Jt .uropa .uropa for jisgedion progres take account of requirements for assessment under European and national legislation for nature conservation.
