Please find the heritage recommendations of the Department of Culture, Heritage, and the Gaeltacht for the above mentioned application.

The proposed dumping-at-sea for Shannon Foynes Port has been evaluated by a Natura Impact Statement and Marine Mammal Risk Assessment. The conclusion of these documents is that the proposed works are unlikely to pose a significant likely risk to nature conservation interests in the vicinity provided appropriate mitigation is implemented. The Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht concur with this conclusion as long as mitigation outlined in Section 5.4 of the NIS is implemented in full.

The proponent should also ensure that other activities not covered by the current application take account of requirements for assessment under European and national legislation for nature conservation.
