## Dairygold Pollution of East Ferry and the East Cork Coastline

I strongly oppose the Environmental Protection Agency granting a waste water discharge licence to Dairygold and TINE Ireland to dump their effluent into Rathcoursey harbour. I sincerely expect that the EPA will do it's job in refusing a licence for this outrageous decision and, protect our harbour, environment and sea life. It seems utterly implausible that the estuary, with variable tides, could flush out 4 million litres of waste a day as proposed by Dairygold/TINE. The north of the outfall pipe is situated in a protected area for migrating birds and home to a number of wildlife including seals and a species of sea bass which is protected under EU Law. We need to try to protect this area and not to destroy it.
