Appeal Re: Extraction of sand and gravel over an area of 7.8 hectares and all associated development on an overall site of 13.9 hectares at Ballinderry, Carbury, Co. Kildare.

Dear Sir/Madam,

I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer to the above-mentioned appeal and your letter dated the 24th September, 2019 requesting comments in relation to an application for a Waste licence or a review of a licence pursuant to the provisions of section 173A(4) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as inserted by Article 10 of the European Union (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Waste) Regulations 2012.

In respect of the Environmental Protection Agency's request for observations and having regard to the specific queries raised in your letter, the Board would wish to comment as follows:

- (i) On the basis of the information made available, it would appear that any importation of fill for the purposes of quarry restoration going forward, would not be covered by the grant of planning permission under PL 09.205039. All works associated with PL 09.205039, including the implementation of the Site Restoration Plan, expired on 30th September 2013.
