This submission is made on behalf of Goode Concrete Ltd, 7th Lock, Killeen Road, Ballyfermot, Dublin 10 in response to a Request for Clarification of Additional Information issued by Kildare County Council on 30 June 2003.

Item No. 1.

The applicant undertakes to construct the entire road generally as shown on Drawing No. 33791-DR-100 as submitted, in accordance-with-the requirements of the Planning Authority. It is proposed that the construction of the roads will be undertaken concurrently with the commencement of development on site, and that the exportation of extracted sand and gravel will not commence until the road has been completed.

Having regard to the significant cost associated with the construction of the road, and the quantity of recoverable resource sterilised by the re-alignment, it is envisaged that the cost of the road will be off-set against contributions and contributions on potential future applications with the administrative area of Kildare County Council.





Figure 3: Detail of proposed new road layout showing location of former mill pond & undisturbed area į Control of the contro Services Ltd. Unit 21, Boyne Business Park, Greenhills, Drogheda, Co. Louth Archaeological Consultancy Site: Client: Declan Brassil & Co. Ltd. Issued for. Request for further information Ballinderry Quarry, Carbury, Co. Kildare 12 Drawing no.: 02 05 C09 Origin: c/o Faber Maunsell Date: 15 August '03 Scale: 1: 1,000 A4 NOCAT Former mill pond 2 7 AUG 2003 RECEIVED EPA Export 01-11-2019:03:43:35
