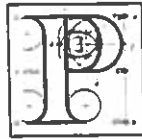

Notice is hereby given by An Bord Pleanála (the Board) under article 112 of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001 that an environmental impact statement (EIS) has been received by the Board in accordance with section 128 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 in respect of each of the appeals in the Schedule below.
