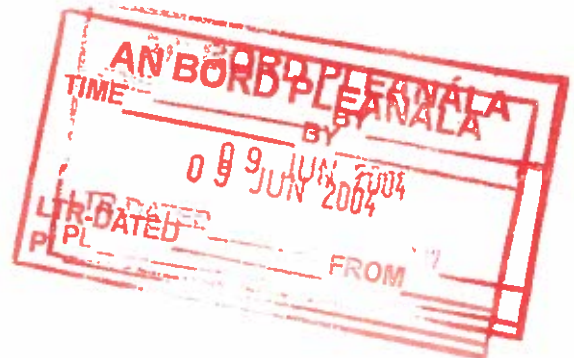

We received the submission dated 17 May 2004 from Declan Brasil & Co. Ltd. (on behalf of Goode Concrete Ltd.). We note the report of David Jarvis & Associates Ltd. regarding the impact of the proposed developments on Ballinderry House. It appears from this report that David Jarvis & Associates Ltd. visited our property on 5 May 2004. From the photographs they submitted, it shows that they engaged in an extensive tour of our lands and buildings. We were first made aware of their visit when we received this report about 3 weeks after their visit. No permission was sought or given for any employees of David Jarvis & Associates Ltd to visit our land. Therefore this report has been compiled illegally by David Jarvis & Associates Ltd. who have broken the law by trespassing on private land. This report, therefore, should not be an acceptable document in this appeal. We refer to our previous correspondence regarding this matter to Kildare Co. Council dated 8 May 2003 and An Bord Pleanála dated 12/4/04. In particular, we, repeatedly, make reference to the last 3 paragraphs of the letter to An Bord Pleanála dated 12/4/04.
