I wish to make a submission/objection to licence (p519-03) and any other licences operated by Gyproc or any of it's associated companies.

1. Noise: disturbs and is a great inconvenience to me and my Family, this level needs to be reduced.
2. Blasting: This is a major inconvenience to me and my Family, this level needs to be reduced.
3. Water discharge : no increase should be allowed, due to the impact it will have on the water quality within the river.
4. Dust: The way dust monitoring is done is out of date.  
(Glass jars in steel tubes under trees)

5. All monitoring should be done by an external body with no affiliation to the company being monitored.

Note.

Pat O'Connor of Gyproc stated on the 10-12-'19 that the blast and noise levels have been the same the past 3 years, as far as we are concerned this information is coming from their own monitoring stations, we do not agree with this.

These issues have massively increased due to the large embankment that protected us being removed. We have line of sight to this company's workings, we feel that the environment and ourselves are not being protected.

P.s noise and blasting has distressed kids in my home while EPA members were present also our horse had to be relocated due to the blasts, this is a major inconvenience to us.
