I write in relation to Dairygold's proposal to release effluent into the inner reaches of Cork Harbour.

A great deal of evidence points to this being a potential ecological disaster for the general area.

In an era when we are being asked to consider environmental issues as a matter of urgency it seems inconceivable that Dairygold will be allowed to abuse the harbour in this way. There is a viable alternative – properly treating the waste and discharging it into a proper tidal area where it will be carried out, on a daily basis.

I am at a loss as to why this is not being done as a matter of course? How has it gotten to the stage where the pipes are already laid? Is this an arrogant assumption on Dairygold's part that the EPA will concur and allow the discharge to exit at Rathcoursey?
