The Environment Section of Kildare County Council have the following observation in relation to the Kilsaran Concrete Unlimited Company, Waste Licence Application, Ref No. W0300-01.

In April 2015 Kilsaran Concrete Unlimited Company applied to the Environment Section of Kildare County Council for a Waste Facility Permit. The Waste Facility Permit application was for 99,000 tonne of soil and stone to restore the southern section of the site.

On the 17/08/2016 Kildare County Council issued a Waste Facility Permit Ref. No. WFP-KE-16-0085-01 to Kilsaran Concrete Unlimited Company.

An officer from Kildare County Council has inspected the site four times a year since the date of issue. The site has been in compliance with the conditions of the Waste Facility Permit during all inspections.
