In response to your letter dated 11th January please note the following:

State whether the activity to which the license applications relates (i.e place free range broiler rearing activity) is permitted by the planning permissions granted for the site.

I can confirm that following discussions between the applicant and Limerick City & County Council's Agricultural Scientist Mr. Aidan Leonard, the proposal to amend the activity on site from a 140,000 non-free-range activity to a free range system of 100,000 birds is not regarded as a material change to the permission permitted under planning ref 18/83 and is acceptable. No further consents are required.
