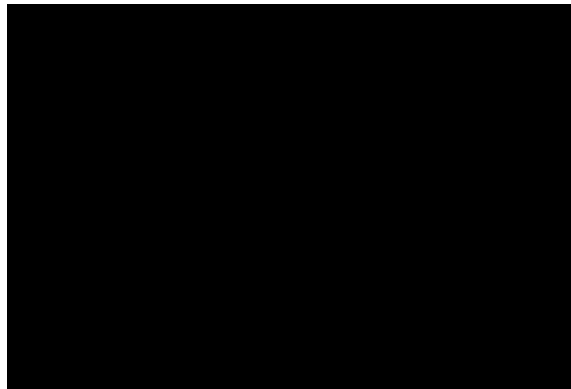
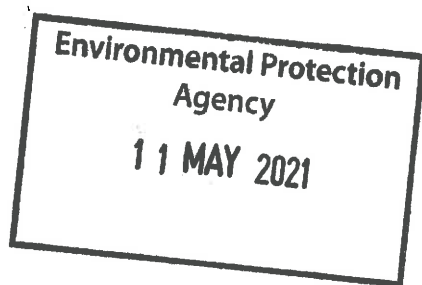

court proceedings / fines between yourself + team.

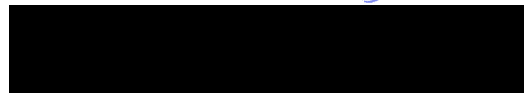
This year saw all the windows in the Schools
