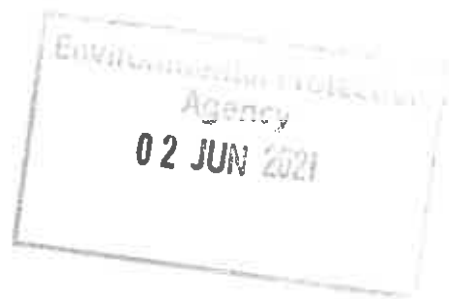

## Introduction

This report only comments on Environmental Health impacts of the licence application.

## General

The Environmental Health Service has reviewed the documentation uploaded to the EPA website in respect of this application.

It is noted that the EPA initiated a review of the existing licence (P0476-02) which was issued on 6/02/2008. This review is part of a review in the ‘Chemical Sector’ initiated by the EPA in order to incorporate Commission Implementing Decision (CID) 2016/902/EU (BAT Conclusions for Common Waste Water)

The Environmental Health Service has not received any complaints in respect of the Recordati Ireland Ltd facility and notes that the application was not made as a result of

- An increase in emissions
- New/relocated emission point(s)
- New abatement equipment

and was not initiated by Recordati Ireland Ltd.

The area in which the facility is located was visited by Ms Monica Jones, Environmental Health Officer, on 21/05/2021 who noted that there were no issues of concern to the Environmental Health Service. The latest AER/EPA site visit reports were reviewed and as a result, the Environmental Health Service has no comment to make on this review application
