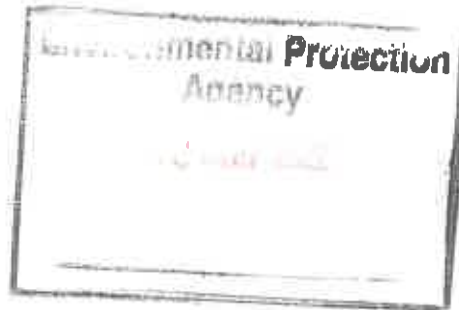

To whom it concerns,

I'm writing to you concerning the piggery at Ballyglasson, Carrickboy, County Longford, about which we have corresponded in the past. I am aware that this piggery has recently been granted permission for 'the demolition of an existing pig house and its replacement with a new pig house, to include slatted floor and slurry tank.' It is also stated that this 'development' is for the purposes of 'an activity requiring an industrial emissions licence'.

Given the applicants appalling record of non-compliance with EPA conditions in the past, we urge you to ensure that any terms laid down in the current proposal will be strictly adhered to or that the licence to the applicant will be refused.

At a time when our planet faces the prospect of catastrophic climate change, and when the government has stated that farmers must reduce emissions by 25%, it seems ill-advised, to say the least, to be granting permission, or to licence any type of intensive farming projects.
