I strongly object to the renewal of the license for the ABP rendering plant in Ferrybank.

I have lived in Ferrybank over 20 years.

Ferrybank is a lovely area and in my opinion, it's completely spoiled because of the stench from the rendering plant.

Here are a few of my reasons:

My wife suffers badly with her oesophagus and can get quite a lot of inflammation as a result of the stench. So, vomiting from the smell can cause a lot of issues for her. When she gets a bad attack, she has serious difficulty breathing.

Having to close the windows and vents in our house because the smell is so bad. It just can't be healthy.

If we have washing on the line, we have to take it in straight away as otherwise, it means that it will have to be washed a 2nd time. The cloths reek of the stench.
