I am a resident in Ferrybank and wish to object in the strongest possible terms to the proposed increase of 60% in the above company's rendering activities.

My objections are on several fronts as follows:

<u>Odour</u>

At certain times the odour from the plant is unbearable if I go into my garden. I think this occurs when they are "cleaning the stack" at night. The smell is simply disgusting and smells of death.

Vehicles bringing carcasses to the plant

On many occasions I have driven behind vehicles bringing carcasses to the plant and the smell form the contents is breath stopping. These trucks also leak fluid which I understand is probably bodily fluids from dead animals. How healthy can that be on a main road past large residential areas?

Health
