Addendum to previous submission

In addition to the content of the previous submission on the above applicant, I wish to add additional content, omitted from the previous said submission.

This plant, its current operating impacts, as well as its plans to expand an additional sixty per cent throughput of offal, will have a detrimental and negative effect on the 13.5 million euro, Waterford to New Ross, South East Greenway, that is due to open in early 2023.

The continuous stench of nauseous odours emanating from this plant, will make this highly beneficial project unattractive to tourists and locals alike. It will be avoided, receive poor reviews and bad publicity, eventually leading to possible failure as a going concern.

The greenway is of great economic and social importance to the South East. The entrance and exit, as well as the initial Abbeylands section along this highly important facility, is located in close proximinity to the ABP plant.

Serious consideration of this issue has to be given, due to these negative impacts.
