Dear Sir or Madam,

I wish to record my serious concerns about the impacts on the surrounding areas of the current operation of the ABP Plant at Christendom, Ferrybank and as a result, I object to the planned expansion of the capacity of this plant.

The odour is particularly concerning for the neighbouring community, in that the lives of their children are impacted when the nuisance is particularly apparent, especially during periods of light winds and calm conditions when the foul odours can remain in the air.

It would appear that the current monitoring and control of emissions from the ABP plant are completely inadequate and that these inadequacies need to be addressed as a matter of urgency. I would therefore call on the EPA to use this opportunity to restrict the continuation of the operation of the ABP plant in its present location and to strongly prevent the operation to expand its facilities in the Christendom, Ferrybank area now, or in the future.
