

A Chara,

Please find the Archaeological recommendations.

It is proposed to dispose of the dredged sediments from maintenance dredging of the Approach Channel, Inner Harbour and Ballygeary Harbour to remove accreted sediment and to restore the charted depths of Rosslare Europort, in the townland of Ballygillane Little, St. Helen's, Rosslare, Co. Wexford. The proposed dump site is in the Irish Sea a distance of 6.5 km offshore from Rosslare Harbour, as indicated on map in Appendix E1.II of the permit application. The site has been previously used and was subject to prior archaeological assessment in 2002. As the site was archaeologically assessed in the past and cleared for use from an archaeological perspective no further archaeological mitigation is required.
