Thank you for your recent notification of the above reference application.

The Lee Reservoir, the receiving water for effluent from Coachford WWTP, is a significant salmonid fishery. In the context IFI would ask the EPA to ensure that current actual background data is applied when calculation of the assimilative capacity relative to legislative requirements is carried out as part of the licence application. The use of a 'notionally clean river approach' is neither sustainable or appropriate.
